She is eager to improve and seeks to learn new strategies. She shows initiative and is professional in her demeanor, speech, and attitude.

Amelia's behavior management is calm yet firm, supportive, and caring. She earned the right to be heard by her students by being fair, consistent, and positive. She kept the bar high for behavior management, despite a challenging group of students.

Amelia created a Social Studies Unit Plan called Past, Present and Future. She used interactive, multi-sensory activities as well as literature to engage her young learners. She crafted the unit using data from pre- and post-assessments and was able to modify her plan as she anticipated student's learning needs. She transformed an abstract subject into a developmentally appropriate unit. Amelia also created some great interactive read aloud slides to go with the reading curriculum.
